INTRODUCTION

MFTHOD

- Access to surgery in Subsaharian africa (SSA) is major public health challenge, with plastic surgery particularly affected
- The burden is poorly quantified, with no comprehensive estimates
- Aim: estimate annual need and map specialized centers
- Data sources: GBD, EUROCAT (pathologies), American and German society of plastic surgeons (surgery rates)
- Pathologies: burns, congenital malformations, soft tissue cancers, hand trauma, breast cancer, pressure ulcers
- For conditions not systematically requiring surgery, intervention rates from US/Germany were applied to SSA
- Plastic surgery centers identified from COSECSA, WACS, published sources

RESULTS

NUMBER OF SURGERY NEEDED


 We estimate that at least 537'353 plastic surgeries are needed annually in SSA.

NUMBER OF CENTERS

 Only 81 centers identified in 17 of 48 SSA countries, leaving 318 million people without access to specialized plastic surgery care

CONCLUSION

- There is a substantial gap between the high volume of reconstructive needs and the limited availability of trained specialists and infrastructure in SSA
- At least 537'353 plastic surgeries are needed annually in SSA
- This study is based on the limited available data and likely to underestimate the actual numbers.
